I am delighted to confirm details of the forthcoming annual SLP Family Fireworks event that takes place at Greenland Community Primary School on the evening of Friday 5<sup>th</sup> November.

#### **ABOUT THE EVENT**

Firstly, we are delighted to be able to welcome our new schools, Annfield Plain Infant School, Annfield Plain Junior School and East Stanley School to this event. For those parents, The SLP Family Fireworks event is a professional display exclusively for families with children attending SLP schools.

Now in its fifth year, this SLP community event has gone from strength to strength and is now a regular feature on the SLP calendar.

#### **HOW TO PURCHASE TICKETS**

Tickets are on sale now priced at £2 per person (no concessions). To purchase them please complete the attached order form and return it to school, payment must be included with your ticket application. Tickets will be sent home with children once allocated. For safety reasons, we would ask that you do not visit your school to purchase tickets as in previous years. All requests should be done through the method detailed above.

In keeping with Safety Advisory Group regulations, everyone attending the event must have a ticket, irrespective of age. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult and anyone in a pram or buggy must also have a ticket.

Once purchased, please hang on to your ticket as if lost we are unable to replace them and you may not gain access to the event.

#### **HOW ARE TICKETS ALLOCATED?**

Due to SAG application and approval, we can only admit a certain number of people. Each SLP school has an allocation of tickets based on the percentage number of children they have on roll which are then allocated to families on a first come first served basis.

#### **REFRESHMENTS**

As well as a small tuck shop, refreshments including hotdogs, burgers, tea and coffee will be available to purchase on the evening.

Alcohol is not permitted and will be removed from anyone bringing it onto the school premises.

## **TIMINGS OF THE EVENT**

The event will be held at Greenland Community Primary School. Gates open at 5.45pm with the fireworks starting at 6.30pm. The display lasts approx. 20 minutes. For safety reasons we do not host a bonfire and both sparklers and alcohol are not permitted.

## **PARKING**

It is very important that you note there is **NO PARKING** at the venue itself, on the main road or in nearby residential areas. As with previous years, the main road leading to residential areas will be coned off. Families are asked to **walk to the school** and not to bring vehicles.

As you may or may not be aware, parking is very limited in and around Greenland and it is essential this is kept free so we have full vehicular access to the area should this be needed in case of an emergency. If you are a blue badge holder, please contact staff at SLP on 01207 266700 to make special parking arrangements.

## **FREE BUS SERVICE**

A free return bus service will be provided to the event travelling from a central location near your school. Please indicate if you require this service when booking your tickets.

Seats are limited so please only book this service if you will use it. Tickets will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Whilst we will endeavour to allocate you travel on the bus you have requested; we cannot guarantee this and may allocate an alternative service.

You will be issued with a travel ticket that will state your departure times, unfortunately, you are unable to travel on a later bus should you miss your allocated bus.

The deadline to book bus tickets is **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> October**.

## **COVID 19**

In the event of Government guidance changing in any way we may need to cancel the event. Should this be the case, all tickets will be fully refunded.

We are delighted to be able to run the event once again and are looking forward to welcoming to it families that are new to the trust. This is a fantastic event in the SLP calendar and we hope, having not held it last year, it will be a huge success.
